

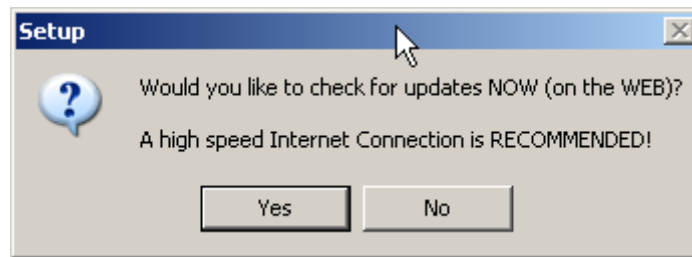
Updates for CogShell and its Assessments (CARB, WMT, etc.)

CogniSyst's Windows implementation now includes a live update program that allows you to obtain and install software updates for our CogShell environment and other popular programs. A version of our update program is shipped and automatically installed from our CD when you install any of our products on your computer. The update program itself has also been updated, and users who purchased software prior to April 2005 should click on the link below in order to ensure that they have the most up-to-date version of this program.

The above link will install or update the update program itself, as needed. There is no harm in using the above program if you already have it—and there is no easy way to determine your version. The installation completes by running the Update program itself, which can then be used to obtain the latest updates for your target machine.

The current setup program (listed above) appears to only work if it is saved locally before it is run. We recommend saving it to your desktop so that you can find it easily. After it is run you can then discard this setup program. When run it will complete the installation by asking if you would like to use the updater now:



Updates can be obtained using either the machine on which CogniSyst's software is installed (the "target" machine) or from a remote (or more convenient, Internet-connected) computer. When the update program is installed and run on a remote machine, the downloaded (SAVED) updates can be transferred via network, memory stick or CD-ROM for deployment on the target computer.

By default all updates are saved in C:\CogShell\Updates\ folder, but they can also be explicitly saved to user-chosen locations.

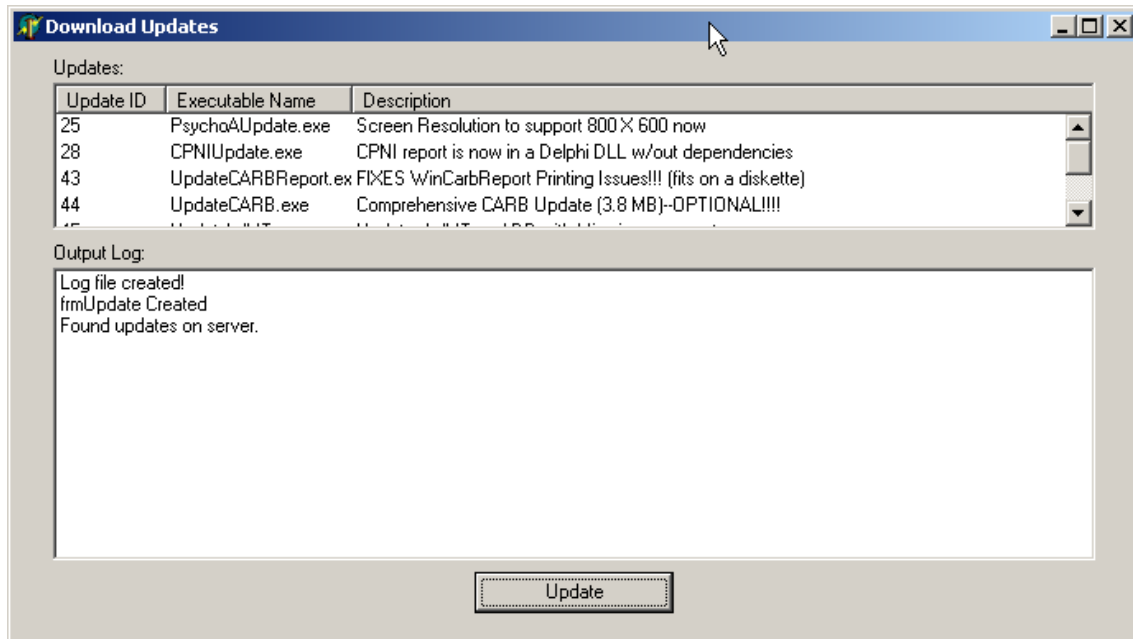
Checking for CogniSyst Updates

If you began this process by using the link above to install/update and run our latest update program, you will already have started the update process and will have no need to initiate is as outlined in this section.

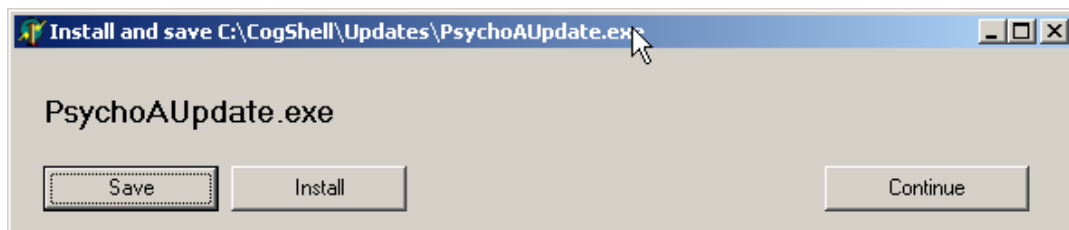
Routinely, or when instructed via email, web post or other communication, you can check for updates using the following menu sequence on your Windows computer:

Start / [All] Programs / CogniSyst for Windows / Update CogShell Apps

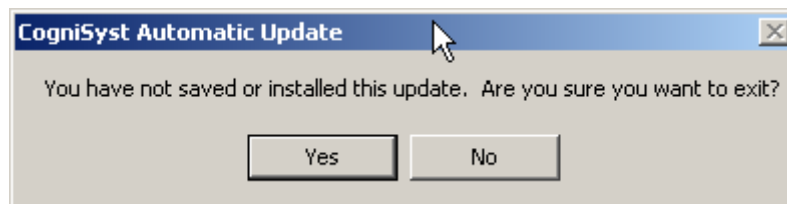
When the program starts you will see something like this:



Press the “Update” button to begin the process. ALL updates will then begin to be downloaded and each one will then be presented for interactive processing in the manner described below:



- **Save** will save, but NOT install this named update.
- **Install** will run the update program (you’ll have to be out of CogShell and our other applications).
- **Continue** must be pressed to move to the next update in the list. You will be warned if you have NOT installed the update—*the message says “exit” but should say “continue”!*



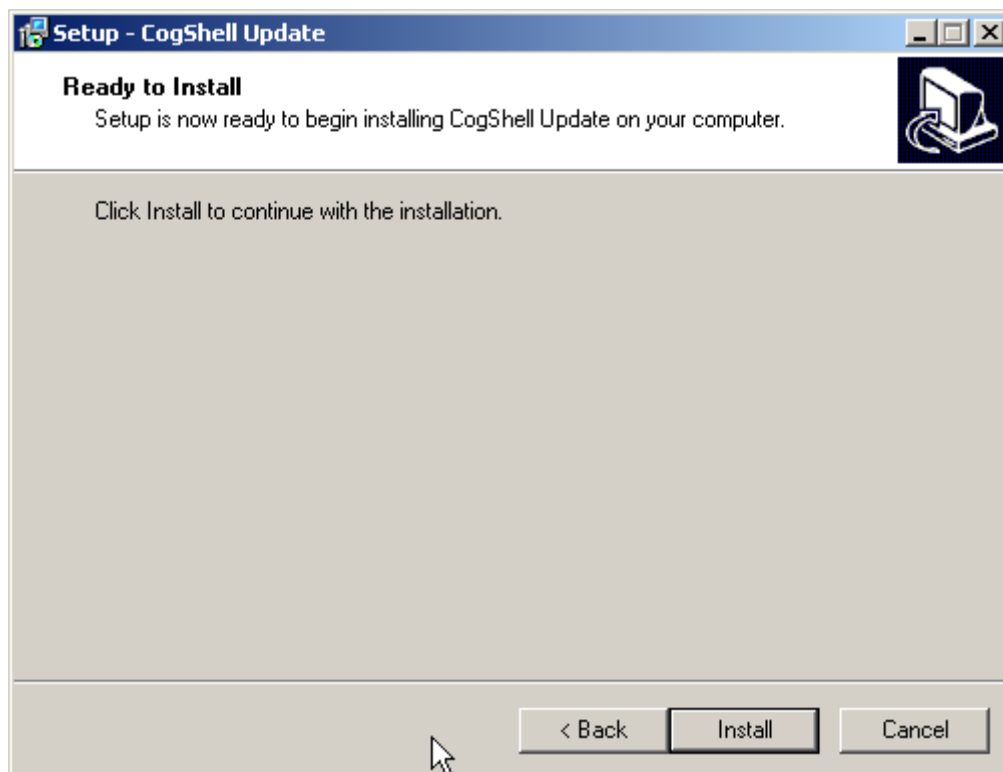
A series of these updates may appear on your screen, based on your needs. Some samples follow.



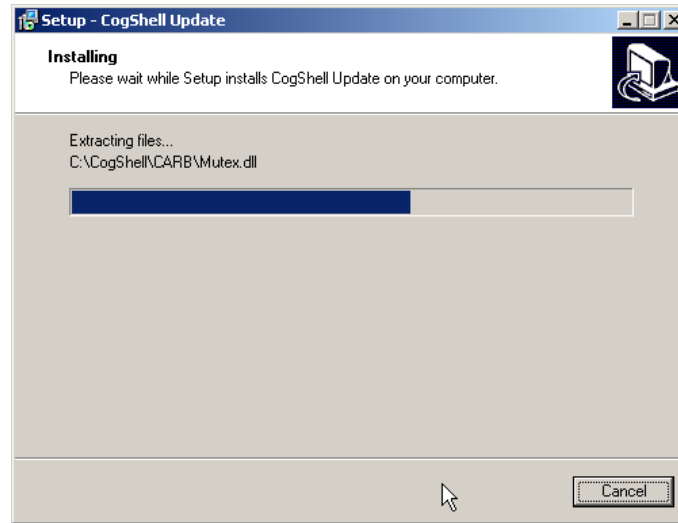
When you Install an update it will begin with a familiar screen such as the one below:



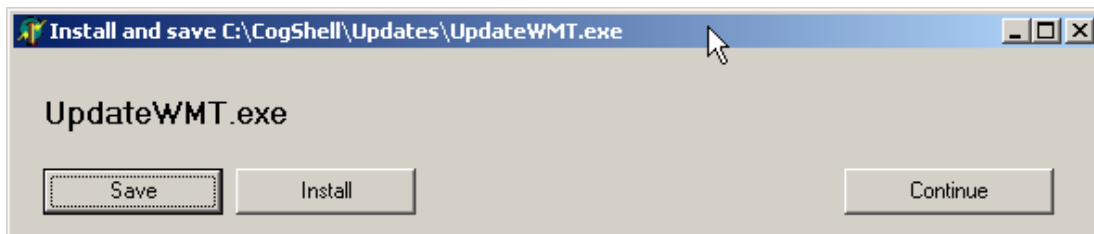
Note that this update pertains to the CARB Report program—the above screen is used generically for most (if not all) of our updates. You may ALSO have to confirm the installation from a screen such as the one below:



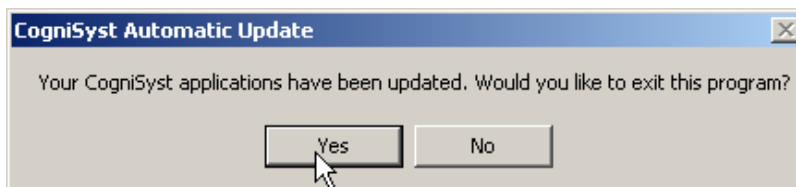
Progress of the update is shown below (an example):



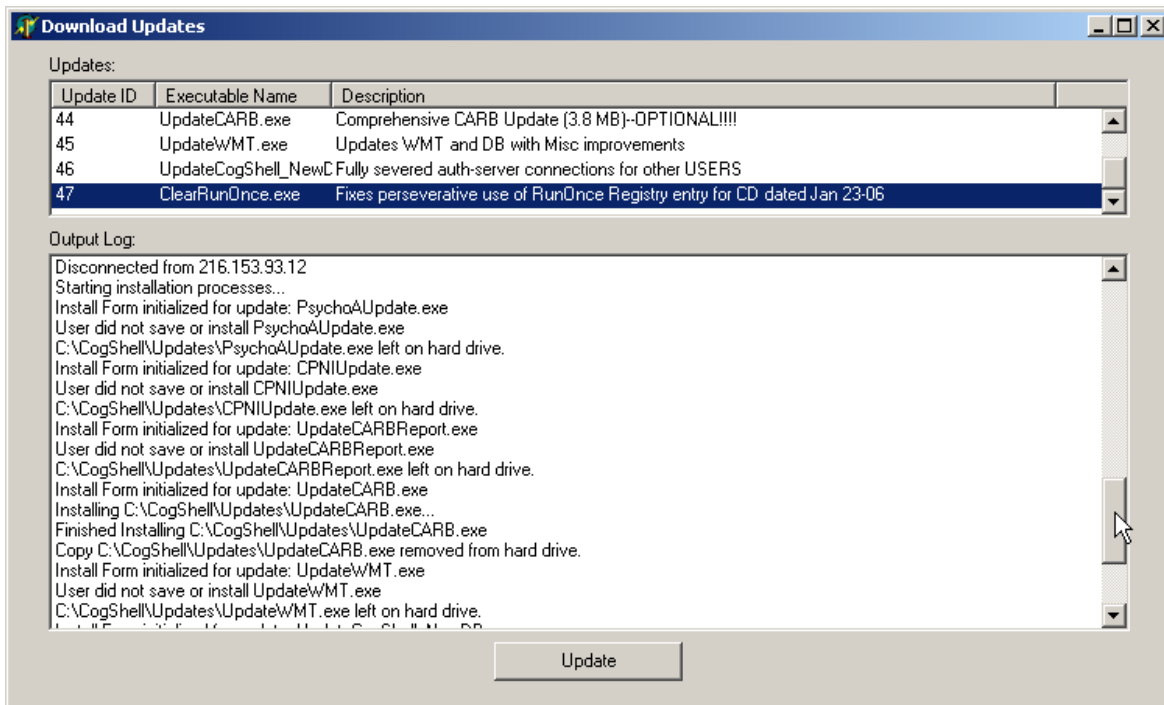
Some updates end without a “Finish” button. In such cases you may simply be given an opportunity to work with the next [another] update (if there are more available).



Eventually you will nothing left to process and you will see this screen:



Why would you NOT exit the program now? Perhaps if you wish to examine the log file:



In this case you will have to close the above window by using the small X in its upper right corner. A final screen will be shown:
